7. Employment conditions

- (1) To promote academic research related to snow and ice-related hazards, risks, and disasters in collaboration with other staff members of the institute. A research budget of 2,000,000 Japanese Yen is available for the first fiscal year (January 1 March 31, 2018).
- (2) Initial term of employment: until March 31, 2020, and then renewed as an assistant professor at the Center for Transdisciplinary Research, Niigata University until not later than April 2022.
- (3) Permanent position at the Research Institute for Natural Hazards and Disaster Recovery will be given upon tenure evaluation for assistant professor or associate professor, based on the "academic achievements," "educational activities," "external fund raising," "contribution to local / international exchange," and others.
- (4) Research space will be given in the building of the Research Institute for Natural Hazards and Disaster Recovery.

8. Eligibility

- (1) Doctoral degree conferred within the last 10 years, or an equivalent research career (Including equivalent degrees such as a PhD from an overseas university)
- (2) Age below 40 years as on March 31, 2018 (born later than April 1, 1978*)
- (3) Should be able to take up the position on January 1, 2018 or no later than March 1, 2018
- (4) Fluent in English and be able to give lectures and research guidance in English
- (5) The successful candidate must have ability and enthusiasm to conduct research and education in collaboration with other staff members of the institute.
- *The Tenure-Track System Promotion Program, funded by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT), follows the project policy of MEXT
- *Applications from female researchers and/or non-Japanese nationals are especially encouraged. Among applicants with equal achievement levels, these

researchers may have priority.

- 9. Application document (1) A signed curriculum vitae including name, date of birth, gender, postal address, telephone number, e-mail address, details of doctoral degree, academic background, professional career, and record of awards / punishments with a photograph of the applicant's face.
 - (2) A list of academic publications: Books and book chapters, doctoral (Ph.D.) thesis, peer-reviewed journal papers, journal papers and reports without peer-review, and international conference papers. Authors, title of paper, journal, volume number, pages, and year should be included in the list. The journal covered by the Science Citation Index should be denoted by '*' in the list. Reprints or copies of important peer-reviewed journal papers (no more than five papers) should be attached to the list.
 - (3) A list of scientific research funds/grants obtained during last five years. Type of the fund, title, specifying the role (principal or co-investigator), and period of funding obtained, should be included in the list. A list of patents and utility models should be presented similarly.
 - (4) A list of awards received. Name of the award, title, name of the awardee, and date of the award should be included in the list.
 - (5) Summary of the research achievements (two pages) and the five-year plan for research and education (five-pages) on A4-size or US letter size sheets.
 - (6) Two contact persons are required to whom we can inquire questions about you. A list of his/her name, affiliation, telephone number and email address should be given.

- i) All submitted material including reprints of papers will not be returned.
- ii) Information on submitted applications will be strictly confidential. Personal information will be protected appropriately in accordance with the Personal Information Protection Law and Rules of Niigata University.

11. Selection process

Initial screening and shortlisting of candidates will be carried out through the evaluation of the application documents. Shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview in early to mid-November 2017. The candidates are expected to make a presentation on their research achievements, future research plan, etc. Please note that travel expenses for the interview will not be provided by the university.
